



**Spring has arrived and so has the 2020 Bath Township Farmers Market outdoor season
We are excited about several new vendors this year!**

The Bath Township Farmers Market will be open for business starting Thursday, May 21st from 3:00 pm to 7:00 pm in James Couzens Memorial Park.

Multiple precautions are being implemented which support the Governor's Executive Orders as well as CDC COVID-19 safety guidelines. Please do not attend if you are not feeling well, experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 (cough, fever, etc.), associated with a person testing positive for COVID-19 or if you have traveled outside of Michigan in the last 14 days.

- Customers may NOT bring their own shopping bag.
- We encourage all customers, who are able to medically tolerate wearing a mask, to wear a mask or face covering.
- Have no more than one or two people in a shopping group.
- All customers must follow CDC hygiene guidelines including frequent hand washing. Hand sanitizer will be present at every vendor table.
- Be sure to maintain a distance of at least 6 feet from others.
- Only one customer will be allowed per vendor at one time.
- Keep Market visits simple and short.
- Try to avoid the need for making change by bringing small bills and/or use a credit card if possible.
- Consider pre-ordering from vendors for curbside pick-up. You can reach the market manager, Tom Straka, for this at (517) 281-7402. The pick-up lane is located along Main Street.
- No food can be consumed while at the Market.
- State and Federal food assistance processing is available.
- Please be courteous and patient.
- Bring a cart, stroller or other equipment to carry purchases and make a single trip through the Market.
